


Message from The Grand Master






Message from The Regional Grand Master

Jabalpur Connectivity

Rail

Jabalpur Railway Station lies on Mumbai-Howrah-via Allahabad main line. Served by the Western Central Railways, Jabalpur Railway Station is an important rail junction of the state as it connects Jabalpur to major Indian cities like Delhi, Nagpur, Kolkata, Mumbai, Hyderabad, Pune, Patna, Bhopal and Lucknow. The venue can be reached by any means of transport.

Road

Jabalpur is connected to major Indian cities like Nagpur, Indore, Bhopal, Pune, Aurangabad, Kanha and Bandhavgarh by regular interstate bus service. Passengers can avail Volvo buses to ply between Jabalpur and Nagpur. The roads are very good if you Want to come by personal vehicle.

Air

Jabalpur Dumna Airport, located around 20 km away from the main city centre, connects the city with rest of the country by air. Jabalpur Airport has taxi services for guests arriving here. In addition to direct flights from Mumbai and Delhi there are flights from and to Hyderabad & Pune.









ABOUT JABALPUR

Located in the centre of Madhya Pradesh, Jabalpur is one of the most important cities in the State. It is situated in the 'Mahakaushal' region and gets its name from history, being the native land of the great 'Jabali Rishi'. Its scenic beauty made it a pleasure resort of the Gond Kings. Jabalpur is a city of growing commercial importance, though it is more renowned for its scenic charms, in particular the magnificent Marble Rocks. Spread across the Vindhyan ranges, it's a beautiful paradise for archaeologists and geologists. The rich chronicling legend of Jabalpur is visible in various forts, monuments and temples, which are visible in different parts of the city and have now, become major tourist attractions of Jabalpur.

TOURIST ATTRACTIONS

CHAUSATH YOGINI TEMPLE

Circular in shape with a diameter of 125 feet, the Chausath Yogini temple attracts believers and others alike. Images placed on its pedestals can be associated to three different periods. Few images belong to the Kushana period, the other to post-Gupta period and the third set belongs to Kalachuri style that existed between 10th and 13th century. You need to climb 108 steep steps to reach the temple.



BALANCING ROCK

The Balancing Rock formations of Jabalpur, which are basically eroded volcanic rock formations, have also survived earthquakes of magnitude up to 6.5 on the Richter scale. It is believed by the local people that nothing can disrupt the balance of these rocks.

KANHA NATIONAL PARK

Spread across 940 sq.km, Kanha National Park is one of the largest parks in Madhya Pradesh where the majestic Royal Bengal Tigers are found in good numbers. The Park is respected globally for saving the Barasingha from near extinction. National Geographic's award winning 'Land of the Tigers' was shot here, and the park is home to leopards, wild dogs and the Barasingha as well. A safari in Kanha is filled with sightings adventurous thrills and is a must.













MADAN MAHAL FORT

A construction belonging to the 11th century, Madan Mahal Fort is a stunning example of the architectural splendour of the past. Constructed by Madan Shah, son of Rani Durgavati, a Gond ruler, the fort served as a watch tower during the reign of the queen. Situated at a height of 500 meters, the fort offers an excellent view of Jabalpur.

MARBLE ROCKS

Situated 25 km away from the main city of Jabalpur on the banks of Narmada River, the Marble Rocks at Bhedaghat present a spectacular image. Rising to a height of a hundred feet, these marble stones reflect sunlight and cast shadows on the pristine water of the Narmada, creating a serene and spellbinding sight. These marble like magnesium limestone rocks cast different colours in different lights and look especially beautiful in moonlight.







DHUADHAR WATERFALLS

River Narmada, considered one of the most important holy rivers in the country falls down from a height of 98 feet forming Dhuandhar Waterfalls. The name of the waterfalls in itself is suggestive of what you could expect there. The term 'Dhuan' means smoke; as the river falls down with force on hard rocks, you can see visuals of smoke rising, which gives the waterfalls the name. Yet another star attraction here is the famed Marble Rocks. Since boating facilities are available, you can have a wonderful experience here.



You would be well rewarded by exploring the length and breadth of Dumna Nature Park, situated 10 km from Jabalpur. This ecotourism site is home to a wide range of wild animals including jackal, spotted deer, leopard, wild boar and porcupine. It is also a bird watchers' delight as migratory birds flock here. It also has a children's park, restaurant and a fishing platform.













TILWARA GHAT

Visit the Tilwara Ghat on the banks of the river Narmada, famous for its natural beauty and historical importance. A Mahadev temple, called Tilwadeshwar Mandir is located on the Ghat. It is one of the locations where Mahatma Gandhi's ashes were immersed.
